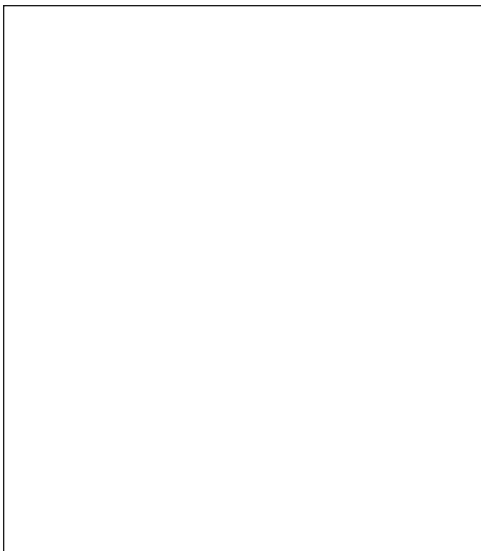
Mission:

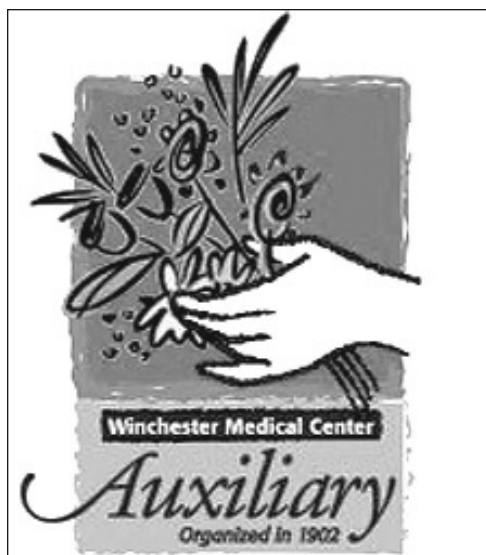

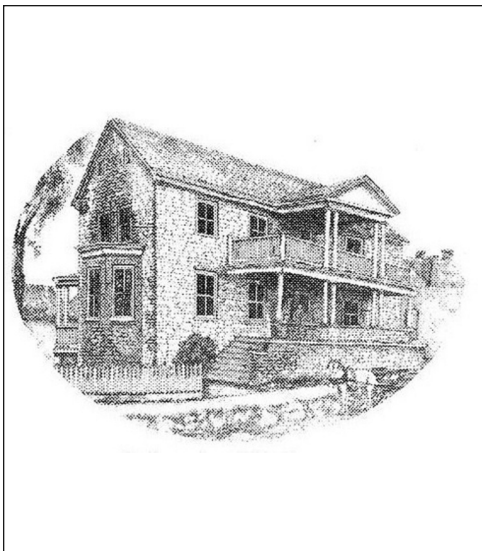
