- 38 Drivers Licenses issued
- 9 vehicle registrations issued
- 4 car titles issued
- 9 birth certificates ordered



## DISTRIBUTIONS

- 150 clothing bags distributed
- 125 Food boxes distributed
- 45 families received diapers
- 250 lunches and 100 breakfasts served



## HEALTHCARE

- 168 people learned about mental health services
- 87 people learned about shelter and domestic violence resources
- 79 dental screenings performed
- Conducted 25+ blood pressure screenings
- 10 heart attack risk screenings



## FAMILY SERVICES

- 45 families received pregnancy and parenting education information
- 70 people learned about youth services
- 16 families signed up for summer food packs



## EDUCATION

- 37 people learned about community college programs
- 5 new students registered onsite for GED classes



## FINANCIAL STABILITY

- 52 people learned their credit scores
- 6 checking accounts were opened for families with no banking relationship.
