
NIGHTS OF SHELTER provided for 7 families (15 people) to quarantine or assist with weekly payments = \$5,000 spent.




PROGRAM GUIDELINES

All households were screened and had to provide documentation showing *loss of income or financial hardship due to COVID-19*.

TOP REASONS:

- Laid off, place of employment closed, or reduction in hours of work
- Must stay home to care for children due school closures
- Unable to work due to high risk of severe illness


EMPLOYMENT BREAKDOWN – CARES ACT RECIPIENTS



OF 528 HOUSEHOLDS






Tony, an 87-year-old Korean War Veteran, came to us to get help with his mortgage and utilities after getting laid off from the restaurant where he worked.


FUNDING BREAKDOWN – CARES ACT PROGRAM


