WE'RE MAKING REAL CHANGES

In 2022, VAN has seen a 50% increase in requests for assistance. Thousands of our neighbors - who have never needed help before - are now struggling to meet their basic needs. An average of 300 new families in need of resources are reaching out each month.

WE'RE MEETING REAL NEEDS

41% of people living in the Shenandoah Valley just can't make ends meet. That's where we come in; to be there for people on their hardest days. We work with local nonprofits to find creative solutions for old problems. We work directly with families to make sure no one gets left behind when they reach out for help.

WE'RE OFFERING REAL SOLUTIONS

We respond to real needs, in real time to help working families in crisis. **Since launching 5 years ago, VAN has resolved 4,000 cases.** That means hundreds of our neighbors are still in their homes, with the lights on, dinner on the table, and a car they know will get them to work tomorrow.
