# **MOBILE FEEDING VAN**

You can fight hunger and poverty by providing healthy lunches to children during the summer. Start with taking up a food collection, pack meals and then deliver them to designated drop sites and meet the families you impact.

# PROJECT HOME SWEET HOME

Help stock apartments for new residents placed through our Valley Assistance Network with basic home goods, and give every new neighbor the chance to create their Home Sweet Home.

# **BACK TO SCHOOL KITS**

Give under-resourced students the tools they need to be successful in school and life.

Everyone deserves the chance to feel clean. Help meet the most basic needs of our neighbors experiencing homelessness.

# **BUILD YOUR OWN CARE KITS**

For many people, being asked for money by a person experiencing homelessness is awkward and uncomfortable. Empower your team to be able to support our homeless neighbors by assembling Care Kits to be kept in their purse or car, and given out to provide substantive help to those in need.

The Valley Assistance
Network (VAN) is a
program of United Way
of Northern Shenandoah
Valley created to help
families navigate
community resources and
create a path to financial
stability. In short, we help
working families move
from crisis to stability.

The team has expert knowledge in resources and solutions to help in unique situations. When employees are stable and healthy, they work harder and have stronger performances on the job.

In the first two years of operation, VAN helped more than 1,500 families connect with medical providers, housing services, food, transportation, counseling, and other critical community resources, to help improve their lives.

# **MOBILE VAN (VALLEY ASSISTANCE NETWORK)**

Bring Valley Assistance Network to your business for three hours to meet your employees and help them navigate any assistance programs they may need.

## YEAR-ROUND SUPPORT \$1,500 (four visits over a calendar year)

- Three hours of visitation from two Valley Assistance Network representatives, four times in a calendar year, at your location
- Priority access to assistance for your employees at Valley Assistance Network

# ON-SITE VISIT FROM VAN \$500 (Per visit)
